Essential information and instructions for nonprofit partners participating in our program.

Your Role as a Partner Nonprofit

Each participating nonprofit helps by:

- Sharing the coloring project with your community
- Distributing permission forms
- Collecting completed artwork
- Matching each coloring page to its permission form
- Submitting artwork in organized batches

How to Use the Stickers

For each submission:

1. Place one sticker on the bottom back of the coloring page
2. Place the matching sticker on the top front of the permission form
3. Paper clip the coloring page and permission form together

Example:

TGMC-01 on the coloring page
TGMC-01 on the permission form

The Matching System (Important)

To ensure every coloring page stays connected to the correct permission form, we use a simple code system.

You will receive:

- Letter/number code stickers (duplicate pairs)
- Paper clips

Artist Reminders (Please Share)

- Artists should NOT write their name on the artwork
 - All identifying information belongs only on the permission form
 - Each person may submit one coloring page
 - Group submissions are allowed (one page, one code)
- ⚠️ Artwork cannot be included without a completed permission form.

Submitting Artwork to JAC

- Artwork should be flat (not folded or rolled)
- Submissions may be turned in in batches
- Pickup or drop-off times will be coordinated
- Receipt of submissions will be confirmed
